- 3) Collect Resident, Town and Committee input
- 4) Identify opportunities for site-specific enhancements and improvements to roadway design
- 5) Identify options for general enhancements to traffic and pedestrian safety

It is proposed that the Committee submits the recommendation regardless of the receipt of "C/CAG" funding; should funding not be granted, the BPTS Committee should consider requesting funds from the Town Council to support this study.

Further to a recommendation to commission a professional study, it is requested that the Committee, in collaboration with Town Staff and Residents, identify issues that can be addressed in the short term. These issues are to be reported to the Town by BPTS.
