✓ ITEMS ACCEPTED:

- Home items and outdoor furniture (e.g. sofas, mattresses, cribs, chairs)
- Rugs and carpets
- Appliances (e.g. washers, dryers, ranges, water heaters)
- Up to 30 gallons of rock, dirt, asphalt or concrete per household
- Up to 30 gallons of construction or demolition debris per household
- Bicycles and exercise equipment
- Scrap metal under 40 pounds and less than 2 feet in length
- Wood waste - unpainted and untreated
- Containerized or bundled tree trimmings - stumps and branches must be less than 6 inches in diameter and less than 6 feet in length
- E-waste - non-working TVs, computers, monitors, etc.

✓ MEDICATION DISPOSAL PROGRAM: (PLEASE LOAD MEDICATION SEPARATELY)

A San Mateo County Sheriff's Office Deputy will be on hand to accept and properly dispose of medications. Please do not dispose of medications in the trash or by flushing down the drain as it is very harmful to the environment.

- Remove excess packaging such as boxes and bottles
- Consolidate pills in a Ziploc bag or a tied-off bag
- No liquid medications or needles

✗ ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED: (NO DONATIONS)

- Appliances containing Chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) (e.g. air conditioners, refrigerators)
- Fuel cans or engine parts containing oil, grease or gasoline (e.g. hedge trimmers)
- Hazardous Waste (e.g. batteries, oil, paint, chemicals, pesticides, sharps, etc.)
