To drop off a voted ballot, there is an interior Ballot Box located in Town Hall during regular business hours from 8 am to 12 pm and 1 to 5 pm Mondays through Fridays.

You can also drop off a voted ballot at any City/Town Hall, Vote Center or Drop Box in San Mateo County from October 9 through November 6. Following is a link to all <u>Vote Center</u> <u>Locations</u>.

Vote Center in Town -

A Vote Center in the Historic Schoolhouse will be open November 3 – 5 from 9 am to 6 pm and on Election Day, November 6, from 7 am to 8 pm. There you will be able to vote by paper ballot or by using an eSlate voting machine, get a replacement ballot, and if needed, register as a provisional voter. There will be Vote Center representatives and poll workers available to help answer any questions you may have.
