#### Updates from Maryann:

Brandi & Maryann went to CalWater office of ratepayer advocates meeting re: SmartMeter pilot program. U-shaped table, no one ID'ed themselves. Very strange and somewhat uncomfortable environment. Brandi will have followup meeting w/ Dawn Smithson. Lots of support for SmartMeters in PV, pilot program. Rate increase would have to be spread among the entire district. Office Ratepayer advocate. Maryann thinks they won't go for it – luxury item, too expensive

Discussion about water leaks, burst hose caused huge bill. Rebecca seems to notice a new leak every week. Most too small to detect. Loverine had gophers digging in same area, finally investigated and found irrigation leak that had been going for months (maybe years?)

Need more testimonials from friends/neighbors re: leaks. Then reach out to neighboring areas in district to garner support for pilot program

Optimal outcome is Smart Meters would be installed by Cal Water. We'll know in ~8 months. Other option is to do something on our own.

Rebecca asked what about the current trial program. Aren't there results for the 25-50 people who have had a smart meter for over a year.

Brandi is maintaining close tabs with Cal Water on the upcoming Rate Case. The Rate Case decision will be made in ~18 months

Maryann is a member of the Resource Management and Climate Protection Committee of C/CAG. They are focused on an update to their 2025 plan with a focus on energy and water. 9/13 Genentech Summit Event JV/CTAG/ Climate Actions That Work.

Maryann has a seat on the San Mateo Countywide Water Coordination Committee. They are working on how to create an overall water management agency for San Mateo County. 18 members Sea Level Rise, flood control storm water mgmt.. Meet monthly, Jeremy is also member. Congresswoman Jackie Spear pushed Dave Pine to be eligible for \$100 Million grant. The Bay Delta Project is focused on ways to keep water in Tuolome River

For the ADU she is constructing at her home, she is installing full gray water recycling. It is fairly complex and expensive. It uses lots of area and feeds into her rainwater capture system.

The Rachio Smart Irrigation Controller has an updated version with available leak detection.

## Updates from Brandi:

Ali Taghavi no longer w/ PV. Brandi will be doing web & communications until they hire a replacement.

Brandi had good meeting w/ Steve from HEA. Waiting for Jeremy to review the letter Steve drafted.

Working w/ Jeff on Microgrid project. Gridscape will present a proposal to TC 9/12. Costs are much higher than TC anticipated, need to understand where these costs are coming from.

Leaf Blower – flyers have been sent, comments were all over the map. There is a lot of misunderstanding. Some people think "electric" means "corded"

Brandi passed some articles around and will send links. Topics include: changing from oil to electric heat, Californians recycling improperly, making water conservation a way of life.
