- Poet Laureate Presentation by Aileen Cassinetto, <u>Poet Laureate of San Mateo</u>

- Current PV Poet Laureate is Lenora Ferro, approved in a previous meeting. Need plans and execution for announcing and recognizing her, as this has not happened so far.
- Jerrie Welch makes a motion to approve Sue Chaput as the chairperson for a subcommittee (up to 3 people) to organize PV Theatre Night, in the community hall, featuring vintage films of PV Plays. Motion is seconded and approved.
- "PV Live Revive" Update October 9th, 2021
 - We have received the contract for the audio contractor. The contract has been forwarded to the Town for approval.
 - We should be getting the quote for the stage later today.
 - Band contract Still working on outstanding items
 - Heidi on Health Compliance update:

- Heidi had a call with Brandi and Kari including site map for permitting, we need an event coordinator for the event (one is fine to handle picnic and concert). The event coordinator must be present at the event for the full day. Patty volunteers to be the event coordinator.
- Patty is handling a checklist for the picnic, supplemented by CAC for concert line items, including food trucks, volunteers, payment, etc.
- Permitting: need permits from Environmental Health and Alcohol permit
- Poster We received a draft but it was featuring the town center buildings with a modern font. We provided feedback for a more "rustic" feel so we are waiting on a new version featuring the schoolhouse and a more "rough hewn" font. We should have an updated poster for review next week.
 - We can use the poster art for postcards, banners, t-shirts, email promo, social media, etc.
 - Funds for a tee-shirt in the Parks & Rec budget
- Patty's updates on coordination with Parks & Rec on porta potties, food, bev, trucks, insurance, etc.: no major updates to share, made good progress on a recent Parks & Rec call. She will apply for the two needed permits for the full day: alcoholic beverage and food + health.
- Discussion of road access to Town Center day-of event and logistics around sound, band arrival. Setting up a call with Greg to talk through logistics.
- **Subcommittee update** on summer concert at TC on Thursday, August 19.
 - Subcommittee is John, Ryan and Tammy
 - Event following the Farmers Market, which ends at 6 pm. Overlap with Farmers Market, begin at 5:30.
 - o Consider asking the chicken guy to stick around.
 - Windy Hill band (Ryan's band) is a bluegrass
 - Subcommittee will work with Tammy to put together a signup sheet for volunteering at the event
 - Need additional subcommittee meetings in advance of next month's CAC meeting.
