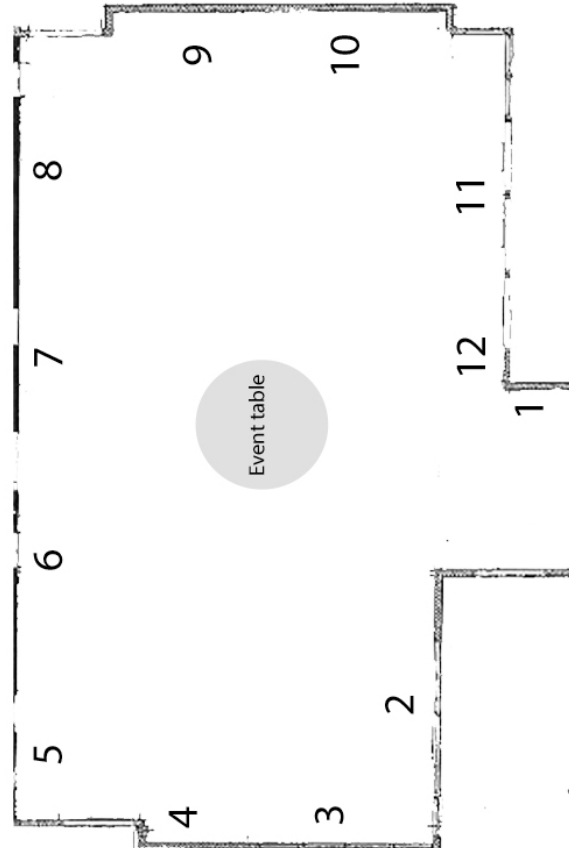

3 steps to prepare for wildfire

1. **Be Prepared.** If the worst happens, be ready to evacuate and have a plan to get your family to safety.
2. **Harden Your Home.** Your home can survive a wildfire. Ember resistant vents, noncombustible/ignition resistant roofing, fencing, siding, and decking can make a difference.
3. **Create a Defensible Space.** Learn how to create ember resistant zones around your home.
