Formerly hidden underground in a culvert, 289 feet of Sausal Creek have been opened up ("daylighted" in creek-speak) for all to see and enjoy!

The creek has been restored from a sterile pipe to a functioning ecosystem with sunlight, water, flora and fauna and improved recreational and ecological value. The daylighted portion of Sausal Creek runs next to the new Portola Valley Town Center, complementing this beautiful facility built with recycled materials and the latest in green building techniques.
